

Hi Dads,

After spending the better part of 20 man hours putting this car together here are my thoughts on how best to do this as a club Event:

1. Designate one Dad as the lead. He will be responsible for buying the Misc. items needed to build the car
 - a. 4' x4' 5/18" Plywood
 - b. Wood Glue
 - c. Nails
 - d. Paint
 - e. 8" spring (For the brakes)
2. Have two or Three dads spend a Saturday cutting out the Wood pieces
 - a. Body Parts (For the Car)
 - b. Brake Pad
 - c. Seat
 - d. Steering Wheel
3. The next day have all the Dad's and Kids come in and sand all the pieces down.
4. You can also put primer on the wood as well
5. While the primer is drying, you can have a couple of the dad's put together the steering mechanism along with the Front Wheels
6. After the Primer is dried, you can attach the front Wheels and Steering Mechanism to the Car Body
7. Attach the rear wheels
8. Put together the seat (With Glue and Nails)
 - a. Note, make sure that the back is slanted in so that the kids can lean back comfortably
9. Attach the Steering wheel casing (I found it easier to glue it around the steering wheel, so I could line it up properly)
10. Attach the Seat to the Body of the car
11. Attach the Brake
 - a. Note, even though the plans call for a pedal brake, I found it easier to make it a hand brake.
12. Let everything dry
13. Paint and Decorate
